EXTRAORDINARY SUPPLEMENTAL DOCKET REQUEST (FORM 10A)

The Nunavut Court of Justice requires 5 business days notice for matters to appear on the NCJ docket. For new charges, the five days should be calculated from the date the information is laid. Dockets are finalized the Wednesday before the scheduled Court sitting. In the event that the RCMP wishes to file additional informations beyond the docket being finalized, this form must be completed and accompany the information. Informations sworn after the Thursday before a scheduled court sitting in a community should be retained by the RCMP and presented to the Court Clerk upon the Clerk's arrival in the community.
