**IN THE NUNAVUT COURT OF JUSTICE**

***EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER***

Effective this 5<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2022 at 8:30 a.m. BY ORDER of the Chief Judge and/or his designate, all court, registry operations, and scheduled sittings at the satellite Courthouse in **Taloyoak** during the week of January 17, 2022 have been suspended until July 18, 2022 pursuant to Practice Directive #37.

The suspension of operations is due to the outbreak of COVID-19 in Nunavut.

All matters schedules to proceed to hearing during this period of closure are hereby adjourned to July 18, 2022.

All filing deadlines that fall before January 17, 2022 are hereby extended to the close of business of July 18, 2022.

Any remand warrant, warrant of committal, removal order, subpoena, summons or other court process that is returnable during this period of emergency closure shall continue in full force and effect until the close of business on July 18, 2022.

All persons affected by this emergency closure are required to attend Court in Taloyoak at 1:30 p.m. on July 18, 2022.
