Emergency Protection Order Information Sheet

You are being served with an Emergency Protection Order. Failure to follow the terms and conditions of this Order may result in a criminal conviction punishable with a fine, jail or both.

This sheet contains information about your rights.

- You have the right to apply to the Nunavut Court of Justice to challenge, cancel or revoke this Order.
- You only have 21 days from today to make your application.
- To start this process, you must fill out a Challenge Form and send it to the Civil Court Registry in Iqaluit. The Court will set a date for a hearing and you can attend in person or by telephone.
- You can call the Court in Iqaluit at 867-975-6108 to get the Challenge Form; or
- Your local Community Justice Outreach Worker [CJOW] can assist you with the form; or
- If your local CJOW is unavailable and you would like help getting a form and filling it out, the RCMP can help you.
- You have a right to receive all of the information that was given to the Justice of the Peace who granted this order. Simply call the Civil Court Registrar directly at 867-975-6108 or go through your local CJOW and ask that all supporting documentation be sent or faxed to the location of your choice.
- At the hearing you will have a chance to present your case to the Judge and to question the other party.
